Teys Australia Rockhampton first slaughter will now be on Monday **April 10th**, 2017. All employees who work on slaughter floor, offal, yards, hides and render should be at work on April 10th. All boning room employees including loadout and ancillary areas are to commence back at work on Tuesday April 11th, 2017. If there are any further changes we will update employees via social media and SMS/MMS.
